- 1. Senate President Learned Dualenroll.com is out and working for us to discover bugs and fixes. They are looking for ways for students to drop themselves from classes. Dual enrollment faculty need to be more careful about rosters. Orientation was on Jan 10th; Pass along Bookstore issues in Divisions to Rebecca, remember to submit book requests including OER or ZTC; Senate Presidents are now being included in the Fraud enrollment discussions going on at the district. The district is using AI to figure out which are likely fraud enrollments; At a webinar about i.d. me and CCCApply a new verification system rollout for next week was discussed and looks promising; The district is responsible for any financial aid money that was sent out to fraudulent enrollments; some classes were overenrolled due to fraud issues too.
