For reference, § 55204 under Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations requires the following:

In addition to the requirements of section 55002 and any locally established requirements applicable to all courses, district governing boards shall ensure that:(a) Any portion of a course conducted through distance education includes regular and substantive interaction between the instructor(s) and students, (and among students, if described in the course outline of record or distance education addendum), either synchronously or asynchronously, through group or individual meetings, orientation and review sessions, supplemental seminar or study sessions, field trips, library workshops, telephone contact, voice mail, e-mail, or other activities.

- (b) "Substantive interaction" means engaging students in teaching, learning, and assessment, consistent with the content under discussion, and also includes at least two of the following:
 - 1. Providing direct instruction;
 - 2. Assessing or providing feedback on a student's coursework;
 - 3. Providing information or responding to questions about the content of a course or competency;
 - 4. Facilitating a group discussion regarding the content of a course or competency; or

- 5. Other instructional activities approved by the institution's or program's accrediting agency.
- (c) Regular interaction between a student and instructor(s) is ensured by, prior to the student's completion of a course or competency:
 - 1. Providing the opportunity for substantive interactions with the student on a predictable and scheduled basis commensurate with the length of time and the amount of content in the course or competency; and
 - 2. Monitoring the student's academic engagement and success and ensuring that an instructor is responsible for promptly and proactively engaging in substantive interaction with the student when needed on the basis of such monitoring, or upon request by the student.
- (d) Regular and substantive interaction is an academic and professional matter pursuant to sections 53200 et seq.(e) For purposes of calculating instructional time in the context of asynchronous distance education, a week of instructional time is any week in which:
