Current College Council Charge:

The general charge of the College Council (CC) is to coordinate and communicate the college-wide planning, budgeting, and reporting processes. The Council also reviews the various proposals and/or recommendations from the various constituents to provide the highest quality learning services to our students and communities served by the College.

Proposed Charge:

College Council oversees the coordination and development of institutional planning through shared governance committees and includes the development of procedures, policies, guidelines and evaluation criteria for reviewing the college's mission and goals, establishing college priorities and reviewing the process and effectiveness of shared governance committees. The Council ensures that there is an inclusive and transparent dialogue [that includes representatives from each campus constituent group] on core campus issues to support the mission of the college. It provides recommendations to the college President on college matters and advises the President to advocate at the District level on college-wide issues.
