

Recommendation #03 from the Office of Associated Students of Porterville College

Request for the ASPC ID Card Price Increase to a \$10.00 per semester fee and transition into an opt-out process.

WHEREAS, the Associated Students of Porterville College (ASPC) is vested with the authority to be the voice of the student body; and

WHEREAS, ASPC has implemented the ASPC ID Card funding program to maintain and strengthen existing programs as well as to establish new programs that will enhance the student academic and student life experiences at Porterville College (PC).

WHEREAS, PC Students are eligible to purchase an ASPC card when students pay a \$10 ASPC ID card fee each fall and spring semester.

WHEREAS, not all students may have the funds available to purchase the ASPC ID Card:

WHEREAS, students will need to opt out of purchasing the ASPC ID card by using the written appeal procedure or policy regarding streamlining the refunds of the ASPC ID card:

WHEREAS, the funds collected by the ASPC ID card directly affect the ASPC Annual Budget;

THEREFORE WE RECOMMEND, that the Associated Students of Porterville College formally request the Office of the President of Porterville College to allow for the current ASPC ID card price to be increased from \$7.50 a semester to a \$10.00 per semester fee.

THEREFORE WE RECOMMEND, that the current opt-in option for purchasing the ASPC ID card be transitioned into an opt-out process.
