Hi Judy,

Thank you for starting this process and outlining both the limitations and possible options in Elumen. I think the committee will need to discuss this further at our next meeting to ensure we move forward with the best approach.

Here are some potential options for implementing the IDEA language:

- **Create checkboxes** within *Methods of Instruction*, using the character limitations you pointed out in your first email. (This option was voted on and approved by the committee last year.)
- Create a box within the *Delivery Methods & Distance Education* tab that must be completed using the reference (as noted in your second email).
- Use the "Other" box within Methods of Instruction and enter the language using the reference.
- Create a separate IDEA form with checkboxes that would need to be added as an attachment.
- Redo the entire revision workflow, which would require all currently active workflows to be rebuilt.
- (Open for additional suggestions.)

Please take a look at these options, or feel free to suggest others, so we can have a productive discussion at our next meeting.




