Hi Dustin,

As you likely have figured out from reading my last email there will be no representative from Fine & Applied Arts present tomorrow. We would like to request to abstain from all course proposals with the exception being BIOL 120 and 160. As a division we actually support the other course proposals but feel an abstentioakes the most sense in case there are any changes that occur to those proposals between now and tomorrow.

We would like to register a "Nay" vote if a motion "to approve" is made for either of these courses. We would like to register this vote because the current evidence and rationale does not warrant the additional contact hours from our perspective. If new evidence and/or claims are brought forth tomorrow we would still like to register a "Nay" vote on the grounds that we would like more time to review any new evidence. Like we both agree, there is no such thing as a curriculum emergency.

If a motion to table these courses is made for either or both of these courses we would support that motion and register a "Yes" vote.
