II. District Facilities Update

- He also went over how to reach the Board presentations documents that list each expenditure.

III. Safety & Security Update

- John Word reviewed M&O projects that have been completed or in progress across campus (see Powerpoint for more detail).
- Review of ongoing projects at Porterville College including HVAC upgrades, main/pipe replacements near Student Center, and bathroom upgrades in AC building, Gym, and Fine Arts buildings which came from Measure J funds.

V. Campus Space Planning

- Review of upcoming projects at Porterville College including Stadium upgrades and Allied Health Building which will both start construction August 2021. When Allied Health Building

goes in then Health Careers portables will be removed to add a relaxation space for students.

- Stadium upgrades include widening field to accommodate soccer, Home bleachers will be refinished, press box refinished, adding new bleachers on the Visitor side, and add in new LED lights. There are also new graphics that will be added to the Stadium and Press Box.
- There is a Career Technology Education Building that is being proposed. It is currently in an approved list with the State but we have not received funding yet. If we receive funding then the Softball and Baseball fields will be moved to the new land acquisition behind the Stadium. This land acquisition is currently in escrow.
- Coffee/Snack kiosks stations across campus are being proposed to help students who may be on campus late at night or do not have enough time to go to the Cafeteria. This will help enhance student life on campus.
- Other items discussed are adding more seating on campus for students.
- Michelle Miller-Galaz discussed a project for the Child Development Center to be repurposed using Title V funds into a dedicated Literacy and STEM space (see Title V Powerpoint for more details). Some ideas for this space are for tutoring sessions, dedicated space for the Writing Center, space for the new Title V Director, dedicated space for PASS sessions, etc.
- There are also ideas on how to remodel the Fine Arts building which could include turning the current Dark Room and Photo Print Room into two separate classrooms.
- The last item discussed was the project by Tree Fresno which will include planting trees appropriate for our climate and water usage around campus. These trees are being donated by Tree Fresno and they will be planted at various locations around campus.
