- II. KCCD Facilities Report reported by Eric Mittlestead

Facilities KCCD Reps - Eric Mittlestead, Joseph DeRosa

- a. Measure G There is money left for PC's Allied Health Building
- b. PC is also using a portion of Measure J for the Allied Health building
- c. Measure J Funds remaining will be used for Allied Health building
- d. The Facilities Report in Board Docs is a live document that anyone can access showing which projects are in the works for PC; Go to the agenda in Board Docs (Arlitha will send out a guide to access the information in Board Docs)
- e. Joe DeRosa is currently working on mapping out PC (to show valve shutoffs (gas, water, electric, and propane))
- f. District has asked for scenarios to be more efficient with energy; Feasibility on more solar; John Word looking at adding possible electric vehicle charging stations
- g. New CTE building is in the Master Plan; it is in the project proposal phase as the next possible candidate for building at PC
